Underground Construction Technology

The recent Underground Construction Technology International Conference and Exhibition witnessed the inauguration of the HDD (horizontal directional drilling) Hall of Fame, as part of the HDD Reunion Reception. The initial inductees included two industry pioneers, Dick Melsheimer and Martin Cherrington.

Dick invented the cut-and-bore method to help develop the first electronic drill bit locating system, establishing the first commercially available HDD rig.

Martin Cherrington, often referred to as "the father of HDD" first conceived the use of HDD as a practical alternative to conventional trenching methods in the 1960s, and founded the Cherrington Corporation in 1984, which has become known around the world as an innovation leader in the HDD industry.

Without the knowledge, skill, and dedication of these two gentlemen, the industry just wouldn't be the same.
